PROCUREMENT OF 30 METRIC TONNES OF THERMOPLASTIC ROAD MARKING MATERIAL AND 2 METRIC TONNES OF GLASS BEADS

The National Works Agency, an Executive Agency of the Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation, through funding from the Road Maintenance Fund intends to procure 30 metric tonnes of White Thermoplastic Road Marking Material, along with two metric tonnes of glass/ ceramic drop-on beads.

Eligibility: Tenderers shall be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the Suppliers of Goods and Services: General Supplies or Safety Products Category and must possess a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC). International firms will be required to register with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) prior to the award of the contract.

Availability: Tender Documents will be available as of **Monday, October 3, 2016**, from the Office of the Planning & Research Directorate, National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10.

Fee: A non-refundable fee of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) cash or Manager's Cheque payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, will be required for Tender Documents.

Return of Tenders: The complete set of Tender Documents along with the required documents: [National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), etc.] should be completed for the procurement and placed in an envelope labelled **"PROCUREMENT OF 30 METRIC TONNES OF THERMOPLASTIC ROAD MARKING MATERIAL AND TWO METRIC TONNES OF GLASS BEADS"**. The envelope is to be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in in the Lobby of National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, no later than **10:00 a.m. on Monday, October 24, 2016**.

Opening of Tenders: Bids will be publicly opened on **Monday, October 24, 2016 at 10:15 a.m.** in the Planning & Research Conference Room, National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10.

Tenders not accompanied by a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration will be rejected.

THE NATIONAL WORKS AGENCY reserves the right not to accept the lowest or any other tender, or to annul the tender process and reject all tenders at any time prior to the award without incurring any liability.

NB. The Contract Period will be sixty (60) days.
