GOJ RURAL ROAD REHABILITATION PROGRAMME – PHASE III MAY PEN TO SOURSOP TURN ROAD REHABILITATION,

The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) has allocated funding **FOR THE RURAL ROAD REHABILITATION PROGRAMME.** The programme of works will be executed by the National Works Agency (NWA), an Executive Agency of the Government of Jamaica to carry out overall improvement works on 8.5km of roadway from May Pen to Sour Sop Turn in the parish of Clarendon.

The Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation (MEGJC)/National Works Agency (NWA) invites eligible contractors to submit pre-qualification applications for the overall rehabilitation of the roadway from May Pen to Soursop Turn.

Scope of Works: The proposed works will be over a distance of 8.5 km and will include geometric realignment, upgrading of drainage facilities with new and improved surface and subsurface drains, upgraded pavement with standard shoulders and sidewalks, improved safety facilities to include reinforced concrete and rubble masonry walls and jersey barriers, improved traffic management facilities to include road markings, raised pavement markers, bus bays and passing lanes.

Eligibility: Pre-qualification is a pre-requisite for Invitation to Tender. Contractors must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in Grade 1 of the "General Road Works" Category, and must have a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) at the time of tendering.

Availability: Pre-qualification Questionnaires (in English) will be available as of **Monday, October 29, 2018** from Project Manager, Rural Road Rehabilitation Programme, National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, Jamaica W.I.

Fee: A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Manager's cheque payable to the Chief Executive Officer - National Works Agency is required for each set of pre-qualification documents.

Return of Documents: Completed Pre-qualification Questionnaires are to be placed in an envelope marked "PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS FOR THE RURAL ROAD REHABILITATION PROGRAMME - MAY PEN TO SOURSOP TURN ROAD." Documents are to be placed in the Tender Box similarly marked and located in the Lobby of the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, JAMAICA W.I., no later than 12:00 noon, Monday, November 26, 2018.

Opening of Pre-qualification Documents: Pre-qualification documents will be opened publicly at **12:15 p.m. on Monday, November 26, 2018** in the Main Conference Room, National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, Jamaica W.I., after which evaluation of these applications will take place.
