TENDER FOR ROAD REHABILITATION WORKS: CROOKED RIVER SQUARE TO BROADLEAF, CLARENDON

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for Road Rehabilitation Works: Crooked River Square-Broadleaf, Clarendon. The works include but is not limited to site clearance, clean side drains, application of 50mm Asphaltic Concrete along the road section as specified.

Eligibility: It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grades 1 or 2 in the Civil Engineering or General Road works category.

Availability: Tender Documents will be made available from **Tuesday, September 25, 2018, until Tuesday, October 9, 2018** from the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10 in the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.

Fee: A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Managers' Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each Tender Document.

Tender Security: A Tender Bond issued by a registered bank or insurance company in the amount of \$300,000.00 or a Manager's Cheque in the sum of \$150,000.00 made payable to the "Chief Executive Officer - National Works Agency".

Return of Tenders: Completed tenders along with the required documents: National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) are to be placed in an envelope labelled "**CROOKED RIVER SQUARE-BROADLEAF, CLARENDON**". The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the reception area of the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders are to be returned no later than **10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 9, 2018**.

Tender Opening: The Tenders will be opened at **10:15 a.m., Tuesday, October 9, 2018** in the Main Conference Room, at the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.
