FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR HIREAGE OF EQUIPMENT

The National Works Agency (NWA) wishes to embark on a two (2) year Framework Agreement with qualified contractors for the Supply of heavy duty Equipment to facilitate the execution of remedial and routine activities across the island. The supply of equipment will be in accordance with the standard equipment hireage rates which are set and revised annually by the NWA on behalf of the Government of Jamaica.

Eligibility: The NWA hereby invites tenders from suitable contracting individuals/entities that are currently registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category of General Services - Equipment Rental. Tenders will also be accepted from the Works Categories - Road Maintenance Works, General Road Works, Civil Engineering Works-or Road Surfacing and Asphaltic Concrete Works.

Availability: Tender Documents will be made available between **Monday, August 8, 2016 and Monday, August 22, 2016**, from the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, in the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.

Fee: A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Managers' Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each set of Tender Documents.

Return of Tenders: Completed tenders along with the required documents [National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or TCC Letter, etc.] are to be placed in an envelope labelled "**FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR HIREAGE OF EQUIPMENT**". The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Lobby of the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders are to be returned no later than **10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 1, 2016**.

Tender Opening: The Tenders will be opened at **10:15 a.m., September 1, 2016**, in the Main Conference Room, National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.

Tenders not accompanied by a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or TCC Letter and NCC Certificate of Registration will be rejected
