APPROACH ROAD WORKS

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation/ National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for the captioned works.

The Scope of Works: This entails the partial milling of existing roadway infrastructure, undertaking protection works to slopes, supplying and installing teardrops and constructing new approach roadways to culvert to the appropriate standards.

Eligibility: Tenderers must be registered with the National Contracts Commission in the Civil Engineering Works Category grades 1 and 2 and shall be in possession of valid Tax Compliance Certificates (TCC) in order to have their tenders considered.

Availability: Tender documents will be available as of **Monday, January 22, 2018** from the Directorate of Technical Services, National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10.

Fee: A non-refundable payment of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) in cash or manager's cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency is required for each set of tender documents.

Return of Tenders: Completed Tender Documents together with all required enclosures (NCC registration and TCC) should be placed in an envelope marked **"TENDER DOCUMENTS, JOHNSON RIVER APPROACH ROADS."** The envelope is to be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Lobby of the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, no later than **12:00 p.m. on Friday, February 16, 2018.**

Opening of Tenders: Tenders will thereafter be publicly opened at **12:15 p.m.** in the Main Conference Room at the offices of the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10.
