PROCUREMENT FOR CONSULTING SERVICES - MONTEGO BAY PERIMETER ROAD PROJECT

DEADLINE: WEDNESDAY, MARCH 30, 2022 AT 12:00 P.M. JAMAICA TIME (UTC-05:00)

The procuring entity is the Government of the Jamaica's (GOJ), National Works Agency located at 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, St. Andrew, Jamaica, W.I., which has allocated funds for the procurement contract: Procurement for Consulting Services - Montego Bay Perimeter Road Project in support to the National Road Operating and Constructing Company (NROCC). For this reason, this Request for Proposal (RFP) is issued. The National Works Agency now invites bidders to respond to this Invitation to Tender on the terms and conditions set forth in the Request for Proposal.

Eligibility Requirements- INTERNATIONAL BIDDERS:

International bidders while not required to submit a Jamaican Tax Compliance Certificate at the time of bid submission, if successful may be required to demonstrate tax compliance in their country of registration prior to the contract award.

Eligibility Requirements- LOCAL BIDDERS

Local bidders while not required to submit a Jamaican Tax Compliance Certificate and Public Procurement Commission (PPC) Certificate at the time of bid submission, if successful must provide the National Works Agency with the following prior to contract signing:

- **A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or Tax Compliance Letter.**

Foreign Consultants must partner with a Jamaican Firm/Company.

Foreign Consultants must provide a Letter of Intent to form an Association with a Jamaican National Firm/Company, which shall be signed by all partners and submitted with the bid, together with a copy of the proposed agreement.

Foreign Consultants must propose an agreement with Jamaican Firm/Company with a minimum percentage of 30 % of the consultancy.

The Jamaican National Firm/Company must meet the following requirements:

- Supervised at least one (1) project with a minimum value of J\$1B
 - Supervised at least one (1) project of a similar nature and size in the last five (5) years.
- A complete set of Bidding Documents in English will be available for download from **Tuesday, February 8, 2022** on the GOJ's Electronic Procurement website www.gojep.gov.jm. Registration instructions are available at www.gojep.gov.jm and all interested applicants are required to register.

Bids must be submitted online via www.gojep.gov.jm no later than **Wednesday, March 30, 2022 at 12:00 p.m.** Jamaica Time (UTC-05:00).

The National Works Agency reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time, without thereby incurring any liability to bidders.

This is an online managed Tender, and bidding documents and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Electronic Government Procurement Portal (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copy) bids will be accepted and there will be no physical tender box for drop-off of bids. To participate in this tender opportunity, bidders must first be registered and know how to use the Electronic Procurement System, www.gojep.gov.jm.
