TENDER FOR ROAD REHABILITATION WORKS: SHOOTERS HILL to KENDAL ROAD, MANCHESTER

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for Rehabilitation Works: Shooters Hill to Kendal Road, Manchester. The works include but is not limited to drain cleaning, formation preparation, base course application and the application of 37mm asphaltic concrete overlay along the road sections as specified.

Eligibility: It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grades 1, 2, 3 or 4 in the Asphaltic Concrete Works, or General Road Works categories

Availability: Tender Documents will be made available between **Thursday July 30, 2015, and Thursday August 13, 2015** from the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.

Fee: A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Managers' Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each set of Tender Documents.

Return of Tenders: Completed tenders along with the required documents: National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), etc. are to be placed in an envelope labelled "**SHOOTERS HILL TO KENDAL ROAD, MANCHESTER.**" The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the reception area of the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders are to be returned no later than **10:00 a.m. on Thursday August 13, 2015.**

Tender Opening: The Tenders will be opened at **10:15 a.m., August 13, 2015** in the Main Conference Room, at the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.

All queries concerning the Tender Document shall be made in writing and addressed to: The Project Manager, Andrew Sturridge, National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, by **Thursday August 6, 2015.**

Tenders not accompanied by a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and National Commission Certificate of Registration (NCC) will be rejected.
