## ROAD REHABILITATION WORKS: PELL RIVER, HANOVER

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for Road Rehabilitation Works: Pell River, Hanover. The works include but is not limited to Formation, Drain Cleaning and Double Surface Dressing as specified.

**Eligibility:** It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission's (NCC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grades 3 or 4 in the General Road Works category.

**Availability:** Tender Documents will be made available from **Wednesday May 11, 2016, until Wednesday, May 25, 2016** from the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10 in the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.

**Fee:** A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Managers' Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each Tender Document.

**Return of Tenders:** Completed tenders along with the required documents: [National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), etc.] are to be placed in an envelope labelled "**ROAD REHABILITATION WORKS: PELL RIVER, HANOVER**". The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Reception Area of the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders are to be returned no later than **10:00 a.m. on Friday May 27, 2016**.

**Tender Opening:** The Tenders will be opened at **10:15 a.m., May 27, 2016** in the Main Conference Room, at the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.
