SHORELINE PROTECTION WORKS

The Government of Jamaica has allocated funding in its 2016/2017 Budget towards the Construction of 90 meters of Sheet Pile Shoreline Protection at the Proposed site of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade, Port Royal Street Corporate Office. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade through the Ministry of Economic Growth and Job creation /the National Works Agency wishes to invite eligible contractors to tender on the construction of these Shoreline Protective works.

Scope of Works: General site preparation of the area to be sheet piled, the purchase and supply to site of 90 meters of Specified Structural Steel Sheet piles; pitching and driving of the Sheet piles to design depths; the construction of dead man anchors; backfilling and the installation of precast concrete caps to the tops of the sheet pile walling

Eligibility for Bid Submission: Bidders must comply with the following criteria at the time of bid submission: Valid Tax Compliance Certificate; Valid National Contracts Commission Registration; Civil Engineering Grade 1 and Piling Grade 1 or 2.; Civil Engineering Grade 1 (Piling Sub Contractor Grade 1 or 2).

Fee: A non-refundable fee of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) cash or Manager's Cheque payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency will be required for each Tender Document

Return of Bids: The complete set of Tender Documents should be completed for the works and returned along with copies of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and National Contracts Commission (NCC) Registration Certificates. All documents are to be placed in an envelope labelled: "CONSTRUCTION OF SHEET PILE WALL SHORELINE PROTECTION WORKS, MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS CORPORATE OFFICE." The envelope should then be deposited in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Lobby of the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders must be recieved no later than 12:00 p.m. on Monday, September 20, 2016.

Bid Opening: Tenders will be publicly opened on **Monday, September 20, 2016 at 12:15 p.m.** in the Main Conference Room, at the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.

Tenders not accompanied by a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or TCC Letter and NCC Certificate of Registration will be rejected
