SECTION TO HARDWAR GAP, PORTLAND

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for Road Rehabilitation Works: Section to Hardwar Gap, Portland. The works include but is not limited to bushing & trimming of banks, cleaning of side drains, pothole patch & repair and application of Asphaltic Concrete to the affected road section as specified.

Eligibility: It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grades 1, 2, 3 or 4 in the General Road Works, or Asphaltic Concrete Works categories

Availability: Tender Documents will be made available from **Wednesday, April 1, 2015, until Wednesday April 8, 2015** from the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10 in the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.

Fee: A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Managers' Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each set of Tender Documents.

Return of Tenders: Completed Tenders along with the required documents {National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC),} etc. are to be placed in an envelope labelled "ROAD REHABILITATION: SECTION TO HARDWAR GAP, PORTLAND." The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Lobby of the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders are to be returned no later than 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 14, 2015.

Tender Opening: The Tenders will be opened at **10:15 a.m. on April 14, 2015** in the Main Conference Room, at the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.

Tenders not accompanied by a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and NCC Certificate of Registration will be rejected.
