### Invitation to Tender

#### REHABILITATION WORKS: GRIFFIN BRIDGE (GULLY), ST. ANDREW

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for Rehabilitation Works: Griffin Bridge (Gully), St. Andrew. The works include but is not limited to site clearance, demolition of gabion baskets, drainage construction, application of 50mm Asphaltic Concrete overlay, the construction of Box Culvert, rubble masonry wall and coping, along the road section, as specified.

**Eligibility:** It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grades 1, 2 or 3 in the Civil Engineering or General Roadworks category.

**Availability:** Tender Documents will be made available from **Monday, January 16, 2017**, until **Friday, January 27, 2017** from the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10 in the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.

**Fee:** A non-refundable payment of J\$3,000 in cash or Managers' Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each set of Tender Documents.

**Tender Security:** Not applicable

**Return of Tenders:** Completed tenders along with the required documents: National Contract Commission (NCC) Certificate of Registration and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC), etc. are to be placed in an envelope labelled "**ROAD REHABILITATION WORKS, GRIFFIN BRIDGE (GULLY), ST. ANDREW**". The envelope should then be placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Reception Area of the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenders are to be returned no later than **10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 31, 2017**.

**Tender Opening:** The Tenders will be opened at **10:15 a.m., on Tuesday, January 31, 2017** in the Main Conference Room, at the National Works Agency's, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10. Tenderers or their representatives are invited to the opening.
