## ROAD REHABILITATION WORKS: MURRAY HILL, ST. JAMES

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of Economic Growth & Job Creation / National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for the captioned works.

The Scope of Works consist of the installation of culvert, drainage construction and application of asphaltic concrete.

**Eligibility:** Tenderers must be registered with the National Contracts Commission in the Civil Engineering Works or General Road Works Categories Grades 1 - 3 and shall be in possession of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) in order to have their tenders considered.

**Availability:** Tender Documents will be made available as of **Tuesday, May 29, 2018** at the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10 from the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects. A non-refundable payment of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) in cash or Manager's Cheque, payable to the Chief Executive Officer, National Works Agency, is required for each set of Tender Documents.

**Opening of Tenders:** Completed tender Documents together with all required enclosures (NCC registration and TCC) shall be placed in an envelope marked **"Road Rehabilitation Works for Murray Hill, St. James."** and placed in the Tender Box similarly labelled and located in the Lobby of the National Works Agency, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10 no later than **11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 12, 2018.** 

**Opening of Tenders:** Tenders will thereafter be publicly opened at **11:15 a.m. on Tuesday, June 12, 2018**, in the Main Conference Room, National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10.
